What to wear

The forecast for Thursday looks good. Sunny with a high of 17°C but please check the forecast the night before and come prepared and dress in appropriate clothes and comfortable shoes. We advise you to have your shades, hat and sunscreen ready!

What to bring

- **Water:** It's important to stay hydrated, so make sure that you have a full bottle of water.
- **Snacks:** There are plenty of cafes, bars and shops around Granary Square, however you might want to pack your own snacks.
- **Portable phone charger:** Just in case your phone runs out of juice, pack a portable charger, if you have one.
- **A placard:** Show the people of the UK why you're protesting! Homemade banners are great and get noticed. Write/print/draw your messages on both sides so that no matter where somebody is standing, they can see your message. Add the #MetaBookThieves #DoTheWriteThing #MakeltFair
